

CURIUM CONNECTS™ In-Home Phlebotomy Terms and Conditions

- Curium Connects™ In-Home Phlebotomy (the “Program”) offers support to patients who are having trouble obtaining required laboratory testing.
- Eligibility for the Program is based upon self-identification or identification by their healthcare provider as experiencing barriers to completing required laboratory testing due to one or more of the following:
 - Transportation challenges (no reliable transportation, inability to drive, lack of caregiver support).
 - Financial hardship related to travel or accessing a laboratory.
 - Physical or mobility limitations that make travel to a lab difficult.
 - Other documented barriers that could delay or prevent completion of required laboratory monitoring.
- Clinical necessity: The service is intended solely to facilitate completion of medically necessary laboratory monitoring ordered by the treating provider.
- No guarantee: Availability may vary by location and vendor capacity.
- Eligibility for the Program will need to be determined for each Bexlutry administration cycle.
- Patients must reside within the geographic service area where in-home phlebotomy is available. Program benefits are only available to residents of the United States and its territories and do not cover costs for medicine or administration. Void where prohibited, taxed, or otherwise restricted by law.
- The Program will not continue to provide Program benefits if the patient discontinues BEXLUTRY™ (Lutetium Lu 177 Dotatate Injection) treatment, opts out of the Program, or after the patient completes treatment.
- Patients may discontinue their participation at any time by calling 844-287-2628, Monday through Friday, 8:00AM to 8:00PM ET.
- The Program is subject to change or discontinuation without notice, including in specific states.
- The Program is in no way an extension of medical treatment provided by healthcare professionals to individual patients.
- By receiving Program benefits, you confirm that you have read, understand, and agree to the Terms and Conditions shown in this document and agree to comply with all rules and requirements.
- Curium may consider exceptions to Program requirements on a case-by-case basis when supported by documented extenuating circumstances and reviewed in accordance with Program policies and procedures. Approval of an exception is not guaranteed and will be evaluated based on the individual facts and circumstances. Reasons for exception may include but are not limited to hospitalization or medical complications, delayed receipt of required documentation, natural disasters or travel disruptions, caregiver emergencies or administrative errors outside the patient's control.
