

CURIUM CONNECTS™ Travel Support Terms and Conditions

- Curium Connects™ Travel Support (the “Program”) offers travel support to patients who meet income and distance eligibility requirements, and their care partners. It may help with transportation, lodging, and out-of-pocket costs related to meals and other travel expenses associated with BEXLUTRY™ (Lutetium Lu 177 Dotatate Injection).
- The Program provides support benefits to the patient and one (1) care partner for travel occurrence for infusion dosing that occurs at the Infusion Center.
- As noted below, to be eligible for assistance, patients must live greater than or equal to 50 miles from their Infusion Center.
- Patients must also meet a household income criteria of less than or equal to 400% of the Federal Poverty Level.
- The Program reimburses eligible patients and their care partner for costs related to meals and other out-of-pocket travel expenses up to \$2000 per infusion for a maximum of 4 infusions for a total of \$8000 for their BEXLUTRY™ (Lutetium Lu 177 Dotatate Injection) treatment.
- Itemized receipts of all incurred expenses are required for reimbursement. Patient and care partner who have incurred out-of-pocket expenses during BEXLUTRY™ (Lutetium Lu 177 Dotatate Injection) treatment are required to submit their receipts within 60 days of their infusion to ensure a timely reimbursement.
- Program benefits are only available to residents of the United States and its territories and do not cover costs for medicine or administration. Void where prohibited, taxed, or otherwise restricted by law.
- Program benefits that are provided by your health insurance plan, Infusion Centers, and charitable foundations should be used prior to utilizing benefits from the Program, as the Program will not provide duplicative support benefits.
- All arrangements for transportation and lodging, including booking, changing, or canceling travel plans, must be made by the patient or caregiver.
- Out-of-pocket costs paid by this Program may not be submitted as claims for payment to any third-party, health plan, charitable foundation, or account such as a Flexible Spending Account (FSA), a Health Savings Account (HSA), or a Health Reimbursement Account (HRA).
- The Program will not continue to provide Program benefits if the patient discontinues BEXLUTRY™ (Lutetium Lu 177 Dotatate Injection) treatment, opts out of the Program, or after the patient completes treatment.
- The Program will discontinue the patient’s eligibility after expenses have been reimbursed for their 4th treatment.
- Patients may discontinue their participation at any time by calling 844-287-2628, Monday through Friday, 8:00AM to 8:00PM.
- The Program is subject to change or discontinuation without notice, including in specific states.

- The Program is in no way an extension of medical treatment provided by healthcare professionals to individual patients.
- By receiving Program benefits, you confirm that you have read, understand, and agree to the Terms and Conditions shown in this document and agree to comply with all rules and requirements.

Other Terms and Conditions

Transportation to and from Home Residence and the Infusion Center:

Transportation support is available only to eligible patients and care partners who live 50 miles or more from an Infusion Center that is accepting new patients and that accepts the patient's insurance and does not have travel benefits provided by the Infusion Center or charitable foundations.

- Transportation options are:
 - **Air Travel:** Air travel support will be available for patients and care partners living 250 miles or more from their Infusion Center. A car service may be provided to and from airports.
 - **Personal Car Use:** If a personal car is used, the Program will reimburse eligible patients for mileage-based fuel costs (at the standard federal per diem rate as defined by federal tax authorities) and tolls. Mileage reimbursement is limited to travel to and from the person's home residence and their Infusion Center for BEXLUTRY™ (Lutetium Lu 177 Dotatate Injection) treatment for distances greater than or equal to 50 miles.
 - **Bus, Rail, or Car Service:** Patients and care partners are encouraged to use bus, rail, or other forms of public transportation, if feasible, for travel to and from the person's home residence and their Infusion Center for distances greater than or equal to 50 miles.
 - **Rental Car:** Rental cars reimbursement will be available for patients who are travelling greater than or equal to 50 miles to the treatment center during the treatment period.
- The Program will only provide necessary transportation support related to BEXLUTRY™ (Lutetium Lu 177 Dotatate Injection) treatment and will not provide or reimburse any travel for nonmedical or nonessential travel, including travel related to personal entertainment, work, or commuting.
- Patients and care partners eligible for transportation benefits may have additional out-of-pocket expenses such as airport parking fees, tolls, and mileage. These expenses may also be reimbursed by the Program.

Lodging Support: The Program will provide travel support for the patient and care partner's stay in a modest room with standard amenities at a hotel near the selected Infusion Center.

- Coverage may vary based on the patient's actual treatment schedule, but could include:
 - Up to 2 business days prior to or after their scheduled infusion as needed per the physician's instruction.
 - Additional nights of lodging will be provided if the treatment physician determines that the patient must continue to stay near the selected Infusion Center for medical purposes, which is more likely during infusion travel
- Patients and care partners eligible for lodging benefits may have additional out-of-pocket expenses such as hotel parking fees and Wi-Fi service. These expenses may be reimbursed by the Program

Meal and Out-of-Pocket Reimbursement Support:

- Meal and incidental expenses may include meals, groceries, nonalcoholic beverages, prepared meal services, laundry (excluding dry cleaning), parking, internet, local transportation, business center expenses (for reimbursement processing only), and tips up to 20%.
- Non-reimbursable expenses include alcohol, entertainment, gift cards, tips over 20%, expenses for anyone other than the patient and care partner, and other nonessential purchases.

Travel Support Exceptions:

- Curium may consider exceptions to program requirements on a case-by-case basis when supported by documented extenuating circumstances and reviewed in accordance with program policies and procedures. Approval of an exception is not guaranteed and will be evaluated based on the individual facts and circumstances. Reasons for exception may include but are not limited to hospitalization or medical complications, delayed receipt of required documentation, natural disasters or travel disruptions, caregiver emergencies or administrative errors outside the patient's control.
